



BOOSTING READING POTENTIAL

WHO: PRIMARY KS1, KS2

KS1 pupils working within low average in relation to national expectations.
KS2–KS4 pupils working 2–3 years behind their chronological reading age.
EAL pupils to support language, reading development & comprehension.

WHAT: BRP is a short 10-week, one-to-one intervention that provides intensive support for children who are in danger of falling behind in reading. It targets children who can read but not efficiently or with little understanding and enjoyment. **The main aim of the course is to:**

- Understand the reading process & researched models.
- Tailor teaching through assessment and close observation.
- Teach strategies & prompts for decoding and problem-solving.
- Plan book introductions and questioning skills to aid comprehension.
- Analyse to inform next steps in learning and precision teaching.

IMPACT: Average reading age increase of 9 to 14 months over 10 weeks.

HOW: One-to-one teaching with a BRP trained TA or teacher / leader, 3 times per week for 10 weeks. Each lesson lasts 15 minutes.

- Applying independent reading skills on familiar texts.
- Ongoing assessment to inform specific teaching.
- Interactive teaching new texts to build independence & comprehension.

Research-based & evidence-informed individual intervention.
